DCSX 2022 – (Updated November 6, 2022)

Dance Jam Productions has set event policies that we believe include appropriate measures to help reduce the risks of communicable disease spread while enjoying our time together. We ask all participants to be mindful of risk and ready to each do our part to protect each other. We are grateful for your cooperation.

- Current, up-to-date vaccination against COVID and seasonal flu is strongly recommended for all participants.
- Masking is at individual discretion. We welcome individuals who choose to wear a mask to protect yourself or as a courtesy to those around you.
- If you get sick or develop COVID, flu or other communicable disease symptoms during DCSX we will promptly refund your ticket purchase and require you to return home or self-isolate. We may ask you to take a test for COVID or flu at any time during the event. If you refuse to take a test upon our request, you will be escorted from the event without refund.

We appreciate your cooperation with these policies. We look forward to working with you to make sure our community is as safe as possible and able to share the gift of dance with each other. If at any time prior to DCSX you decide you are not comfortable with our health policy or code of conduct expectations, we will refund your ticket purchase with no questions asked.
